March 5, 2021

The regular monthly meeting was called to order by Mayor Leslie King. Roll call: Laura King, Lorene Roberts, Mike Roberts, William Atchison and Orville Lippe Also present: Dalton Larson/Water Supervisor/ Troy Burluson/Police Chief/ Chris Jamison/Police Sergeant/Bill Melbourne/Police Officer

The minutes from the previous meeting were distributed and discussed. William mentioned that there was a correction that needed to be made to the minutes, where it says 250 people to change to 25. Troy mentioned that Bill is certified for traffic now. Troy also mentioned that he and Leslie attended a meeting to discuss the towns helping or assisting if needed and everyone is on board. Troy mentioned needing to sign the agreement. A motion was made by Mike, seconded by William the agreement to allow mutual aid to the other towns. All in favor.
